ACADEMIC SCHEDULE

The academic schedule is divided into semesters. Classes meet three times per week: Two 65-minute classes and one 80-minute class, with five periods per day in addition to an Advisory period.

DUAL CREDIT

In lieu of AP / IB courses, Juniors and Seniors in good standing are encouraged to enroll in dual credit classes. The Winston School currently partners with Dallas College to offer numerous Upper School classes for college credit.

UPPER SCHOOL ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

All 9th graders participate in the Freshman Seminar, a foundational course focused on executive functioning skills. Starting in 10th grade, students apply to one of four Academies—Leadership, STEM, Fine Arts, or Global—each offers college-level coursework and research in their chosen area. Seniors complete a year-long Capstone course, which includes research, professional experience, and a final project plus presentation to the Winston community. This required course demonstrates college-level analysis and presentational skills.
